Re: Annual Report to the President of No-Knock Entries by Special Agents of the Federal Housing Finance Agency Office of Inspector General (FHFA-OIG)

Dear Mr. Eichenthal,

This report responds to section 10(c) of Executive Order 14074, which calls for the heads of Federal law enforcement agencies to issue annual reports to the President – and to post those reports publicly – setting forth the number of no-knock entries that occurred pursuant to judicial authorization; the number of no-knock entries that occurred pursuant to exigent circumstances; and disaggregated data by circumstances for no-knock entries in which a law enforcement officer or other person was injured in the course of a no-knock entry.

From May 1, 2022, through March 28, 2024, FHFA-OIG did not use any no-knock warrants in support of our investigations and did not participate in any no-knock warrants in support of any other law enforcement agencies.

FHFA-OIG will continue to monitor this activity and report it annually at the start of each fiscal year, beginning October 2024. This report will be posted on FHFA-OIG's external website, at <u>www.fhfaoig.gov/notices</u>.
